DESCRIPTION: Incoterms are used by merchants in the course of contracts for the sale of goods. Merchants commonly fail to understand the nature of the precise terms, such as Cost, Insurance and Freight ("CIF"). Incoterms shift the risk of loss.

Insurers commonly use Incoterms in all risk cargo policies. Insurers look to determine or exclude coverage.

Incoterms were significantly changed in 2010. Brokers, insurers, claims and risk managers should be aware of these changes and their impact on the shifting of the risk of loss and the corresponding effect on coverage.
